CC&R Reminders

As always, and since there are monthly questions from *new and established* residents in our neighborhood, the Board believes it would be helpful to re-enforce two very important issues regarding resident responsibilities surrounding the Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions (CC&R's) governing Greenfield Estates. The reminders are as follows:

• Plans for any outdoor "structure or

thing" on your property must be presented to the POA Board of Trustees <u>in advance</u> for consideration.

• No utility or pleasure vehicle or equipment, including mowers, tractors, campers, boats, boat trailers, house trailers or other pleasure vehicles shall be stored or parked on any lot for more than seven (7) days unless they are entirely within a garage or other enclosed area.
